III. MRA Discussion & Review of Cabinet Goals

The MRA is our Leader In Me assessment that we do each year to measure how we are progressing as a Leader in me school. At the beginning of the year Cabinet identified three lower MRA scores and used those to generate goals for the year. These goals have been the focus of our Action Teams.

Below is a description of each goal we have worked on, our target score and example questions that students were asked. Jim asked cabinet members to review these with their team and continue to come up with ideas and suggestions on how we can improve in these areas in relation to the responses that we would expect for our students. .

Cabinet Goal #1 - SELF ADVOCACY

Students work to overcome barriers, problem-solve, and find solutions on their own and know how to enlist support when needed.

Our score: 71/100

Our target score: 85/100

Example Questions:

(Students) Asking an adult for what you need.

(Students) Getting help to reach your goals when you need it.

(Students) Standing up for yourself when you need to.

(Students) Telling a friend when you need something

(Students) Working to develop your strengths and talents.

Cabinet Goal #2 - TRUSTING RELATIONSHIPS

Students have a high trust relationship with at least one teacher they feel comfortable with and can connect to.

Our score: 72/100

Our target score: 85/100

Example Questions:

(Students) I can be myself around my teacher.

(Students) I can talk to my teacher when I have a problem.

(Students) My teacher is easy to talk to.

(Students) My teacher understands me as a person.
