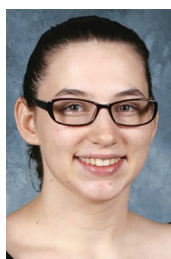

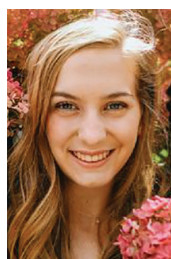

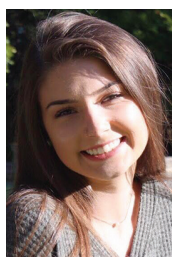

She has been part of many community service projects, most notably the Annual Sacred Heart Food Drive. In the fall, Mattie will be attending the University of Richmond to swim and pursue a major in healthcare studies.

Graceann Bennett, daughter of Jeff and Michelle Bennett, is currently enrolled in the New Visions Health Careers Exploration program. She serves as the president of Varsity Club and the Class of 2019, is the historian of Spanish Honor Society and is a member of National Technical Honor Society, National Honor Society, Spanish Club, Weightlifting Club, and the Captain's Leadership Council. She has earned Principal's List for every quarter since seventh grade. Throughout high school, she competed as a captain on Lake George's Varsity basketball and volleyball teams, being named Adirondack MVP for both. For basketball, Graceann earned First Team All-State for Class C, a spot on the News Channel 13 All-Star Team, and Times Union Small School Player of the Year. This year, she won Top Scholar Athlete for Section 2 Girls Basketball and the Post Star Teen Excellence Award. To become a Lighthouse School, Lake George Elementary School had to demonstrate how it meets the following criteria:

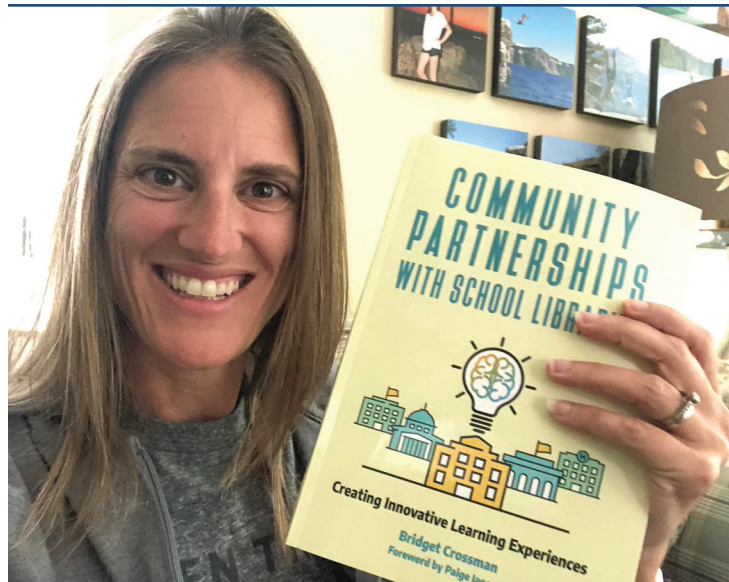

Capital Project Update

Following voter approval of the Capital Improvement Project in December 2018, Tetra Tech Architects met with administrators, teachers, buildings and grounds staff, school resource officers, and coaches to begin the design process. Consultants verified existing conditions and incorporated the results into the project drawings and specifications that will be submitted to the NYS Education Department (SED) for approval. The Project Team also developed details for the building permit set.

The district solicited proposals for construction management. After a thorough review process, Chazen Associates was hired to manage the project and coordinate invoices, payments, and submissions to SED.

The capital improvement plans will be submitted to SED for approval in July. Depending on SED workflow, the plans are expected to be reviewed and approved by January 2020. In the meantime, the district's project team will conduct walkthroughs over the summer to develop a detailed timeline for construction that will have the least amount of impact on teaching and learning.
