

Capital Project Update

Following voter approval of the Capital Improvement Project in December 2018, Tetra Tech Architects met with administrators, teachers, buildings and grounds staff, school resource officers, and coaches to begin the design process. Consultants verified existing conditions and incorporated the results into the project drawings and specifications that will be submitted to the NYS Education Department (SED) for approval. The Project Team also developed details for the building permit set.

The district solicited proposals for construction management. After a thorough review process, Chazen Associates was hired to manage the project and coordinate invoices, payments, and submissions to SED.

The capital improvement plans will be submitted to SED for approval in July. Depending on SED workflow, the plans are expected to be reviewed and approved by January 2020. In the meantime, the district's project team will conduct walkthroughs over the summer to develop and detailed timeline for construction that will have the least amount of impact on teaching and learning.
