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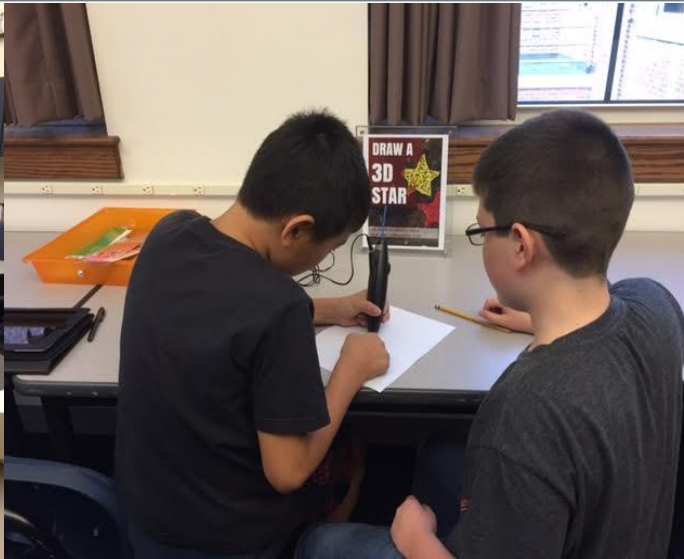

7th Grade Exams

- NYS ELA and Math Exams in April
- Periodic iReady assessments
- Final exams in June

***Notes from the Nurse:**

Physical exams are required for all 7th students.

Physicals are also required for those students playing sports each year. In order to play you must have a physical within 12 months of the start date of the sport.

Any medications to be given or taken at school, prescription or over the counter, must have a written order signed by the doctor and parent.

Students are to go to the nurse to be excused when sick and are not to just text/call a parent to pick them up. Students must sign out in the attendance office before leaving.

Q & A

What time does the school day end?

The school day ends at 2:33 pm. However, there is a 10th period that all students are encouraged to attend for extra help with teachers or for a club activity. Students may also participate in various activities taking place in the library 10th period.

How does my child get involved in Modified Sports? Contact the Athletic Director for specifics on sports offered in 7th grade.

When can my child practice opening their lockers? We provide time for students to practice locker combinations the week prior to the start of school.

Is my child allowed to have his/her cell phone in school? Yes, students are allowed to access their cell phones before school, after school, during lunch periods, and in-between classes only.

What can my child do while waiting for sports practice to begin? Students may work in the library, attend a club meeting, or work with a teacher in a classroom. Students may not leave campus for any reason.
